CATHERINE PALACE



Catherine Palace (Pushkin) – one of the best examples of Russian baroque with incredible collection of art. Named after the Empress Catherine I the first royal owner of the imperial palace in Tsarskoye Selo. We may never see again many of 57 palace's halls which where destroyed during Second World War. Extensive restoration efforts managed to recreate 29 of original halls, including legendary Amber Room. It will remain the most dramatic mysteries in the history of art. Assembled with over 500,000 pieces of amber like a huge puzzle.
